

Statement About NCNS

Nepean Community Neighbourhood Services (NCNS) is an innovative grass-roots organisation that works with and for the people of our community to provide services and community development programs for those who need them most. We work across five centres in the Penrith Local Government Area (South Penrith, Cranebrook, Werrington County, Penrith and the Koolyangarra Aboriginal Family Centre in Cranebrook) and deliver programs and services across the Greater Western Sydney, Nepean, Blue Mountains and Lithgow regions.

We work through a model of partnership and collaboration, linking children, young people and adults with the support they need, with a history and focus on working with Aboriginal communities. Our work is grounded in the principles of social justice – equity, access, participation and rights - and we focus our resources on those who are the most disadvantaged and least powerful groups in our community, providing quality programs that are grounded in respect and that build community capacity, strength and inclusion.
